

THE GROWING TOGETHER PATHWAY

A CONNECTED JOURNEY OF SUPPORT FROM PREGNANCY TO TODDLERHOOD

Welcoming a baby is a life-changing journey — and you don't have to take it alone. Our Growing Together Pathway offers a supportive, friendly and expert-led series of programmes for parents and baby from pregnancy to age two. Each step is designed to build confidence, connect with others and support your child's development.



Parenting Pathway (0-2 years):

A structured and supportive journey for new parents, beginning during pregnancy and continuing through toddlerhood.

- 1. Ante Natal Support Preparing expectant parents for birth and the early days of parenting. Get ready for birth and beyond with essential guidance, emotional support, and practical tools.
- 2. **Bringing Baby Home** Immediate postnatal support focusing on the transition home and early bonding. Helping you settle into life with a newborn with support for feeding, sleep, and early bonding.
- 3. Post Natal Support Bump-Start Babies (Drop-In Group) A casual group offering peer support and expert advice for parents and babies. Continued emotional and practical support in the early weeks. A relaxed space to connect with other parents, chat with experts, and share the ups and downs of early parenthood.
- **4. Baby Massage** Strengthening parent-infant bonds through nurturing touch and relaxation techniques. Gentle techniques to strengthen your baby's development and deepen your bond through touch.
- **5. Baby-Start** Support for the first exciting months focusing on play, routine, development and parental well-being. Supporting developmental milestones and parent confidence in the early baby months.
- **6. Toddler-Start** For growing little ones and growing challenges we explore behaviour, communication, and toddler independence. Focusing on toddler development, behaviour, and growing independence.
- 7. **Dad Matters Support** Dedicated support for dads, integrated across the pathway, to ensure inclusive parenting support. dads are supported, included, and connected every step of the way.

Report from "Dad Matters" co-ordinator Dan:

As a Dad Coordinator in West Somerset, my goal is to create a welcoming community where dads can come together, learn from one another, and enjoy new experiences. I'm passionate about coming up with a variety of ideas to encourage involvement and build connections that support everyone's growth.

Some of the activities I organise include dad walks, where we enjoy a walk, have a good chat, share a laugh, and then maybe stop off for a pint. I also run pop-up barber shops in the local area, offering dads the chance to get a haircut, have a friendly chat, and feel comfortable opening up if they want to.

In addition, I provide one-to-one support for those who might need a bit of extra help. Sometimes, as a dad, it can be hard to know exactly what your role is or what to expect, especially with so much media around making it look like dads don't struggle. I believe it's really helpful to hear from real dads about their experiences, what works, and what they've learned along the way — all in a relaxed, friendly environment.

My focus is on creating positive, supportive spaces where dads can meet, share, and feel part of a community that cares. It's all about coming together, having a good time, and supporting each other along the way.

MONTESSORI

Project Overview

The purpose of the project is to raise the quality of provision of Montessori-inspired, child-centred programmes of engagement for families, parents and children across West Somerset through the provision of Home-Start initiatives.



This will be achieved by the Recipient using Baby-Start as a leading programme of work; inspiring other projects, initiatives and programmes to be led by the Home Start West Somerset team.

'On the 16th of May 2025 Family Support Coordinator Hayley travelled to London to represent Home-Start West Somerset at Nursery World's Big Day Out.

The event and invitation were due to our endorsement and collaborative work with Montessori Global Education and Hayley spoke at the conference alongside Karen Chetwynd their CEO about Partnership working and the innovative way in which we share our best practice through our service.

We were the Home-Start Charity present at the event and Hayley waved the flag to promote West Somerset and our challenges, such as having such a large area to cover, rural barriers and how we have overcome them to achieve great outcomes.'

'Hayley continues to develop the journey with Baby-Start and has involved Home-Start volunteers in groups and the upcoming practitioner training pilot, which begins in September. The aim is to ensure the legacy of Baby-Start at HSWS and within our community.

Hayley has also developed another pilot programme this year called 'Montessori Moments – Prepared Environments', with the first session held at our base in Alcombe and then it will travel to Williton, Minehead's Little Fishes group and Dulverton across our area. This is a parenting style programme that follows Montessori practices with themes linked to Baby-Start condensed featuring a focus on' Parents as their Child's first Educators'.

The hope is to bring enrichment and wellbeing for families accessing our Pathway, with a solid foundation in empowering parents to be present and mindful in their family life'.

'Home-Start West Somerset Cannington in the Spring with our Pathway of Baby-Massage with Bump-Start Lead Caroline and followed this with a course of Baby-Start. Hayley arranged for a volunteer linked to the community in Cannington to be present for the duration of her sessions and this inspired the opening of an ongoing Baby-Group in Cannington. This has now become a toddler group as their babies have grown, and we are now looking back to our Pathway to offer the community Toddler Start to inspire their volunteer and family leads.

Following on from this model that has previously worked in Stogursey too, we will look next to Dulverton!

Nearly £1500 was raised. Thank you all.


